Wednesday	Bathroom cleaning
Thursday	Dust furniture
Friday	Mop floors
Saturday	Yard work
Sunday	Meal preparation

Monthly Chore List Chart

Ideal for tracking larger cleaning projects such as:

- Cleaning windows
- Washing curtains
- Deep-cleaning appliances
- Organizing closets
- Cleaning the garage
- Replacing air filters

Family Chore List Chart

Assigns tasks to multiple family members.

Typical columns include:

- Family member
- Assigned chore
- Due date
- Completed
- Notes

Kids Chore List Chart

Designed to make chores fun and rewarding.

Age-appropriate chores include:

Ages 3–5

- Put toys away

- Feed pets with supervision
- Make bed
- Water plants

Ages 6–9

- Set the table
- Fold towels
- Sweep small areas
- Organize school bag

Ages 10–12

- Vacuum rooms
- Empty dishwasher
- Clean bathroom sink
- Take out recycling

Teenagers

- Cook simple meals
- Laundry
- Mow the lawn
- Clean bathrooms
- Grocery shopping

Kitchen

- Wash dishes
- Clean countertops
- Sweep floor
- Empty trash
- Clean refrigerator

Bathroom

- Clean mirror
- Scrub toilet
- Wipe sink
- Mop floor
- Replace towels

Bedroom

- Make bed

- Organize clothes
- Dust furniture
- Vacuum carpet

Living Room

- Dust shelves
- Vacuum
- Organize books
- Wipe tables

Outdoor

- Water plants
- Mow lawn
- Sweep porch
- Wash car
